The student has to create an account and download his documents. (see guidelines attached)</p> <p>We send the admission letter at the end of May for Fall semester and at the end of November for spring semester.</p> <p>Learning Agreements are prepared after admission letter.</p> <p>We plan a meeting with students selected and international coordinators of the hosting campus to prepare the arrival and to help with administrative procedures (VISA, accommodation, etc....)</p> <p>STAFF:</p> <p>For Erasmus+ staff mobility, we only accept staff that has been nominated by the International Office of home institution. We would require a CV and a statement for your interest in coming to CESI.</p>
